Laura stated Lisa called her residence at 1840 hours and asked her about an email and asked her when she changed her email address. Laura had no idea what Lisa was talking about. Laura then asked Lisa to send it to her so she could read the email.

The email was sent to Lisa from mb-959@hotmail.com, but was signed by Laura and Jeff Braun. Laura and Jeff have no idea who sent the email. Laura is bothered by this incident because of the content inside the email. Laura is also concerned about who the email was sent to considering she is currently in a new position with Oak Hills Schools.

Laura talked this incident over with Lt. Howarth and the email was sent to Detective Roberts, so he can try to find out the sender of the email.

She was not a direct recipient and it is an obvious parody. I did look at the header information and the email originated from I.P. address 74.215.46.133 on 1-5-08 at 2008EST. This I.P. address belongs to Fuse (Cincinnati Bell). It emanated locally but without a court order I can not identify the sender. This information was passed onto JSB.

Request this case be closed as unfounded.
